

Scheduling Appointment for Driving Test

The Driver Education course meets most of the requirements of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles. It includes 30 hours of classroom instruction and 8 hours of on the road training. Students will need an additional 32 hours of driving to meet the 40 hour driving requirement.

In order to ensure that your son/daughter has meet the required skills and is prepared to take the exam for the Drivers license with the DMV, the on the road instructor will let the student know when he/she is ready to take the test. This will usually be by the 6 th on the road training instruction. (Assuming parents are also driving with the student.)

Parents will need to conference with a driving school instructor if they wish to use the “Off-Site Testing Services” which is when DMV comes to driving school to administer the “On-The-Road-Test” only. If no conference is held it is assumed you wish to bring your child to test on their own at the DMV of your choice. The fee for this service is \$75.00

If you use the “Off-Site-Testing” service your child will need to wait 48 hours after successfully completing the road test then go to DMV in HAMDEN to pay for and receive their license.
